

# Crystal Reports 2008 Advanced

## Conditionally Formatting Data

Use the Highlighting Expert to apply formatting to specific data based on a condition.

1. Select the field on the report containing data to format.
2. Choose **FORMAT > HIGHLIGHTING EXPERT** or **[F10]** on the Experts toolbar.
3. To create a new condition, click **NEW**.
4. In the first step-down list, choose the field to evaluate.
5. In the second step-down list, choose the type of comparison.
6. In the third step-down list, choose the value of the field in the conditional statement or type in a value, if necessary.
7. In the remaining step-down lists, choose the desired formatting for the selected field. The formatting will apply if the conditional statement evaluates to true.

## Using the Formula Editor for Conditional Formatting

Use the Formula Editor to evaluate complex conditional statements or to change format properties not available through the Highlighting Expert.

1. Select the field containing the data to format.
2. Choose **FORMAT > FORMAT FIELD** or **[F10]** on the Experts toolbar.
3. Right-click the field and choose **FORMAT FIELD**.
4. Choose the tab containing the property to be changed.
5. Click **OK** next to the property to change based on a condition.
6. For properties that can be set to multiple values, type a formula that returns the appropriate value. Constants are provided with a list of values the function can return. Refer to **Using Creating Formulas Using If** (C:\Program Files\SAP\Crystal Reports 2008\Help\).

For properties that can be either on or off, type a formula that evaluates to true or false. If the condition is true, the property will be enabled for that record.

1. Choose **OK** (Save and Close) **[OK]**.

## Creating Report Alerts

Use Report Alerts to react to an alert when a condition is met.

1. Choose **REPORT > ALERT > CREATE (OR MODIFY) ALERT**.
2. To create a new alert, click **NEW**.
3. Type a name for the alert in the **NAME** box.
4. Type a message to display when the alert is triggered in the **MESSAGE** box.
  - Click to create a message that includes a function or calculation. Click **OK** to launch the Formula Editor. Enter a formula for the alert message. Click **OK** and **OK**.
5. **EVENT CONDITIONS**. The Formula Editor displays.
6. Type a condition that can be evaluated to true or false.
7. Click **OK** (Save and Close).
8. Click **OK** (Save Close).
9. Click **OK** to attach report data. The Report Alert dialog is the condition is true.

**MESSAGE VIEW RECORDS** to display the records that meet the condition.

## Inserting Sections

Add new sections to a report to improve data management (e.g., a section can be suppressed if there is no data for the record in that section).

1. Choose **REPORT > SECTION EXPERT**.
2. Select the section from the list on the left, and click **INSERT**. The section will split in two, with the top section containing the objects that were previously inserted.
3. In **Preview** or **Design View**, Right-click the section name on the left and choose **INSERT SECTION**.

## Modifying Section Properties

1. Choose **REPORT > SECTION EXPERT**.
2. Select the section from the list on the left.
3. Modify properties on the **DETAILS** tab. Fields, tabs or **GROUP** tab, **GROUP** tab.

Note: Section properties may change for each section. **DETAILS** for additional details about each property.

## Changing Section Order

Change the section order when multiple sections have been inserted and the order of data must be adjusted. Note: Section names will change when their order is changed.

1. Choose **REPORT > SECTION EXPERT**.
2. Select a section to be moved.
3. Click the arrow **[<]** or **[>]** at the top of the Section Expert to move the selected section. **[OK]**.

## Conditionally Formatting Sections

1. Choose **REPORT > SECTION EXPERT**.
2. Select section from the list on the left.
3. Click **OK** next to the property to be changed. The **Format Color dialog** (not available in the Formula Editor) is used to change the Format Color dialog. Refer to **Using the Formula Editor for Conditional Formatting**.
4. Click **OK** (Save and Close) **[OK]**.

## Using the Group Tree

1. To create a group, choose **REPORT > GROUP** or **[G]** from the menu.
2. In **Preview** view, click on the function field by choosing **VIEW > EXPANDED FIELD**, **[VIEW EXPANDED]**, if necessary.
3. Click on the group in the tree to navigate to the first group of that group's data.
4. Click **W** to expand and collapse subgroups.

## Drilling Down in Groups

Drill down on a group to analyze data contained in it.

1. In **Preview** view, Double-click on the group name within the report or Right-click the group name in group tree and select **DRILL DOWN**.
2. A new tab appears to the right of the expanded tab, displaying the drill-down group data.  
To close the drill-down tab, click **[X]**.

## Modifying Group Options

1. Choose **REPORT > GROUP EXPERT** or **[G]** on the Experts toolbar.
2. In the **GROUP BY** section, select the group field and click **GROUP OPTIONS**. The **Grouped Group OPTIONS** dialog box appears.
  - In **Preview** or **Design View** (Right-click the group header or footer on the left and choose **GROUPED GROUP OPTIONS**), modify properties on the **DETAILS** tab.
3. To change the group sort order, modify properties on the **DETAILS** tab.
4. To change page layout, modify properties on the **OPTIONS** tab.
5. If the group sort order is set to **BY FIELD ORDER**, modify properties on the **BY FIELD ORDER** and **BY FIELD** tabs. **[OK]**.

Note: Additional properties for group options can be found in the Section Expert. See **Using Highlighting Section Properties**.

## Using the Cross Sort Expert

Use the Group Sort Expert to sort all data based on group summary values. Before using the report, choose **REPORT > SUMMARY** to learn summary values for the group.

1. Choose **REPORT > GROUP SORT EXPERT** or **[G]**.
2. Select the group tabs containing the summary data to analyze.
3. Select **OK** from the step-down list.
4. Select the summary values to sort from the **BY FIELD** tab step-down list. **[OK]**.

## Selecting Records Based on Summary Data

1. Click **REPORT > SUMMARY EXPERT** or **[S]** on the Experts toolbar.
2. Select the group tabs containing the summary data to analyze.
3. From the step-down list, select **OK** to use **BY FIELD** or **BY FIELD ORDER**. In **BY FIELD** select the 3 summary groups and **BY FIELD** to select the 4 summary groups based on selected summary data.
4. From the **BY FIELD** tab step-down list, select the summary field to select records.
5. From the number of groups to select as **BY FIELD** is 3. **[OK]**.

## Inserting Subreports

Use a subreport to learn data from one report into another report. The entire subreport will change and refresh based on the criteria in the container report that it is inserted into.

1. Choose **REPORT > SUBREPORT** or **[S]** on the Experts toolbar.
2. Select **DETAILS** tab (summary expert). Click **DETAILS** to locate the subreport. **[OK]**.
3. Click **OK** (Save and Close) to save data to display in the subreport based on selected data in the container report.
4. Click **OK** to insert the subreport. The group changes to an arrow with a rectangular outline.
5. Click **OK** to place the report in a section.

## Modifying Subreport Links

Use subreports to display selected data in the subreport based on selections in the container report.

1. Right-click the subreport and choose **DETAILS SUBREPORT LINKS**.
2. From **BY FIELD** tab on the left, choose the field that will be used to select the data in the subreport. **[OK]**.
3. Click the **GROUP** tab in **DETAILS** under the **BY FIELD** header to indicate that **GROUP** fields should select records from the subreport that match data from the container report. **[OK]**.
4. Choose the field in the container that contains the selected data in the step-down list on the right.
  - 1. **[OK]**.

Note: Only fields that have the same data type can be linked.

### Conditional Formatting Properties

Click **OK** next to the following properties to change format on a condition.

Field	Format or Field Link
Background	Change background color
Font Color	Change font color when condition is met or when alert is triggered
Image	Hide or display image or picture
Display Format	Change the data that is displayed
